

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TOWN OF DARIEN**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a public hearing will be held by the Town Board of the Town of Darien at the Town Hall located at 10569 Alleghany Road, Darien Center, New York on the 3rd day of November 2021 commencing at 7:40 p.m. to give citizens the opportunity to consider a proposed local law that will allow the Town Board to adopt a budget for the fiscal year 2022 that requires a real property tax levy in excess of the limit specified in General Municipal Law §3-c.

The State Legislature and the Governor enacted legislation that establishes a “property tax cap” on the amount that a local government’s property tax levy can increase each year. Said cap is 2% or the rate of inflation, whichever is less, with some exceptions. Local communities have the ability to override this cap with the adoption of a local law.

The Town Board of the Town of Darien will ensure that proper safety protocols are followed based upon the Phase of reopening that New York State attains and any additional Executive Orders issued by the Governor by said date of public hearing. Face coverings will be worn and social distancing maintained to ensure the safety of the public.
